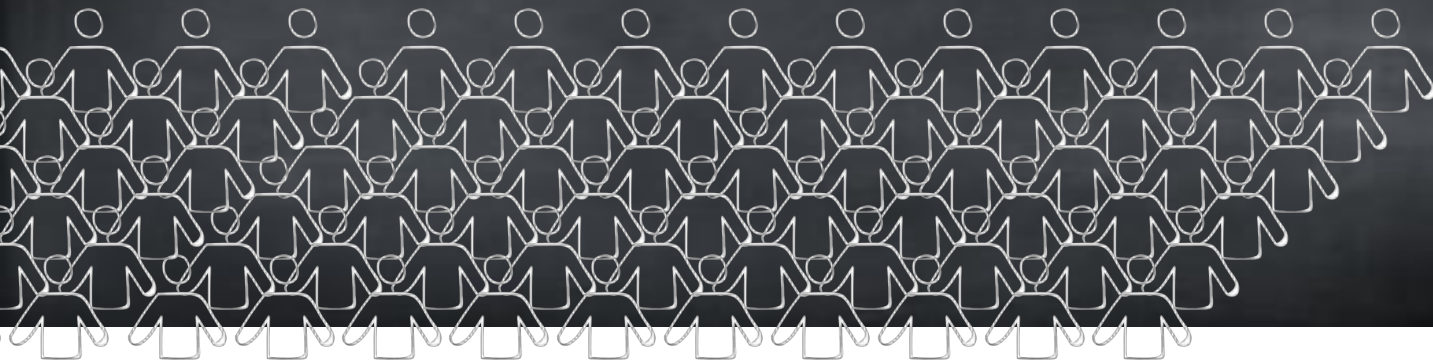


# So all good? No!

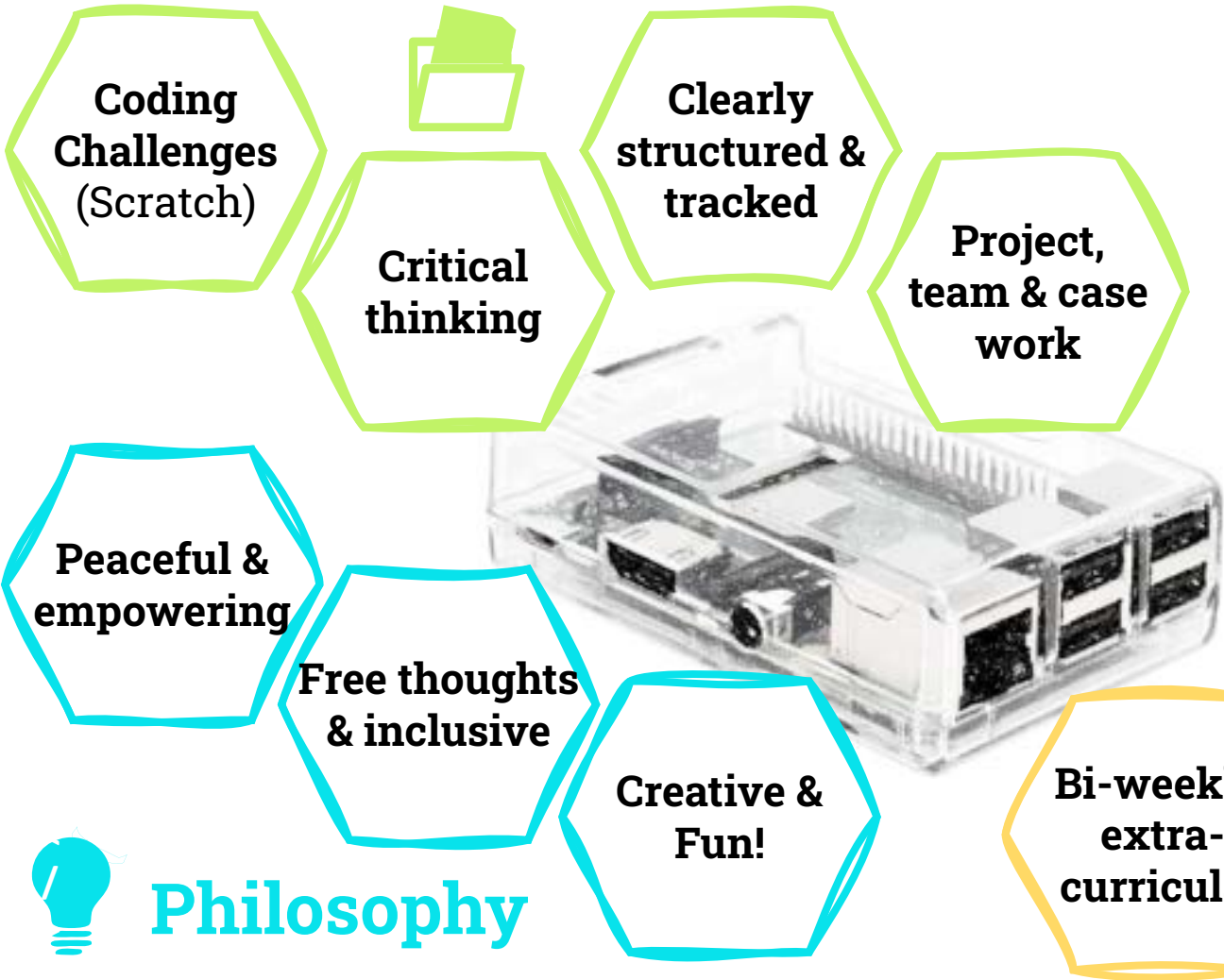

**Founded in 2018**  
we made our first improvised steps with our coding program – at the public beach and in the classrooms of local schools



**Start of building our first own ICT-Lab in 2020**  
in cooperation with the German Embassy, it was a big milestone for Grow Ghana



**Opening of the ICT-Lab @Langma-School in 2021**  
now we are able to teach 20 students at once with vital IT-Skills in a state-of-the-art environment



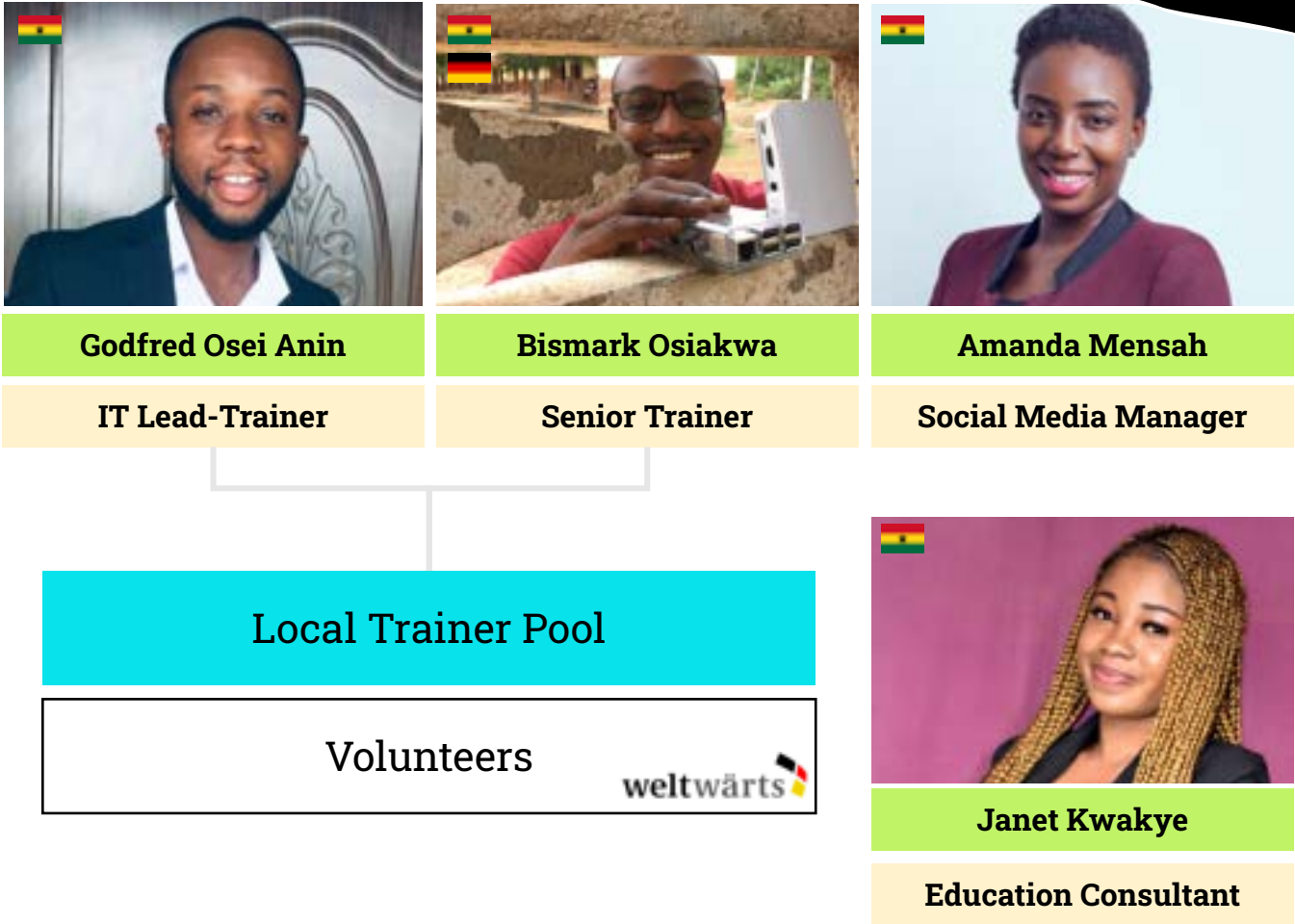
